Benefits

In order to reap the benefits of email, you must first set up an account. Why go through the set up process? Many people communicate by email. Companies are doing away with paper mail or offer an email option to save costs and be environmentally conscious. Online shopping sends tracking information and receipts through email. Emails are also used for longer communications and are a way to share valuable documents. Additionally, since text messages can only handle small amounts of pictures and videos, email is a great way to send larger numbers of pictures and videos at once and preserve their quality. And email through Google (Gmail) is completely free!



Prerequisites

- iPhone with IOS 12.x or later
- Active mobile provider (e.g. Verizon, Sprint, AT&T)
- Apple ID added to iPhone



Introduction

The word "app" is short for application. An application tells your phone how to do a related set of tasks. In this guide, you will learn how to create an email account through the mail app.

Email and texts have become the primary types of electronic communication used on smart phones. (Texts and emails are each covered in separate Quick Start Guides.)

Your coach will support you as you use this guide to set up your new email. Once you have set up this account, you will not need to revisit any steps in this guide. You should speak with your coach about using the mail app to compose, send and receive email. Please write or draw on the pages in any way that will help you.

Different people like to communicate in different ways. When adding someone to your contacts, ask them if they prefer calls, text or email. Using their preferred method when you contact them will help you to get a quicker response.



Creating an Email Account


Step 1. Open (start) the Mail App.





Creating an Email Account (continued)


Step 2. From list of email providers, we recommend you choose *Google*. Google's email program is called Gmail, and is very widely used. It is completely free.





Creating an Email Account (continued)


Step 3. Click (tap) Create Account.





Creating an Email Account (continued)


Step 4. Enter your first name and last name, then **click** (tap) *Next*.





Creating an Email Account (continued)


Step 5. Enter your birthday and gender, then **click** (tap) *Next.* You can enter any date you want for birthday and opt not to select a gender. This is a personal choice.





Creating an Email Account (continued)

Step 6. Create your Gmail address by choosing one of the suggested addresses. We highly encourage you to enter one you create, shown in the next step.






Creating an Email Account (continued)

Step 7. In below example,


DorotTechCoaching2019@gmail.com was added as a new email address. NOTE – if you pick your own, you may have to try several times to find an email address that is not already in use by someone else. Only letters (a-z), numbers (0-9) and periods (.) are allowed in your chosen address. When ready, **click** (tap) *Next* to continue.





Creating an Email Account (continued)


Step 8. Select a password of at least 8 characters, using a mix of letters, numbers and symbols. To ensure it is the way you want, you will be asked to type it twice. When done, **click** (tap) *Next*. Remember to write down this password somewhere where you can find it should you forget the password.





Creating an Email Account (continued)

Step 9. If desired, you can associate a phone number with this account. This can make it easier to access a forgotten password. This guide will skip this step. Scroll to bottom left of screen and **click** (tap) *Skip*.





Creating an Email Account (continued)

Step 10. On Privacy and Terms screen, it is highly recommended that you read what you are agreeing to. Please know that should you not agree, you will not be able to set up the account.

Data we process when you use Google

- When you set up a Google Account, we store information you give us like your name, email address, and telephone number.
- When you use Google services to do things like write a message in Gmail or comment on a YouTube video, we store the information you create
- When you search for a restaurant on Google Maps or watch a video on YouTube, for example, we process information about that activity – including information like the video you watched, device IDs, IP addresses, cookie data, and location.

Combining data

We also combine this data among our services and across your devices for these purposes. You're in control

Depending on your account settings, some of this data may be associated with your Google Account and we treat this data as personal information. 
